# CONSENT FOR IMPLANT SURGERY

- **OPTIONS** -- for missing teeth include:
  - 1. Accept gap
  - 2. Removable denture
  - 3. Bridge fixed or bonded to adjacent teeth
  - 4. Dental Implant (s)
- **RISKS** -- of implant surgery include
  - 1. Failure to integrate to the bone (success rate is approximately 96%)
  - 2. Risk of gum recession and change in your gum contour
  - 3. Bleeding and infection
  - 4. Rarely numbness and sinus problems

### • ADVANTAGES

- 1. Are independent of natural teeth and therefore minimise risk and compromise to your own teeth
- 2. Stronger than other options
- 3. Preserve bone

#### • **DISADVANTAGES**

More expensive than other options and involves minor surgery

#### • GRAFTING

Bone grafting and soft tissue grafting may also be required to augment the sites. This may be your own tissue or approved animal products.
